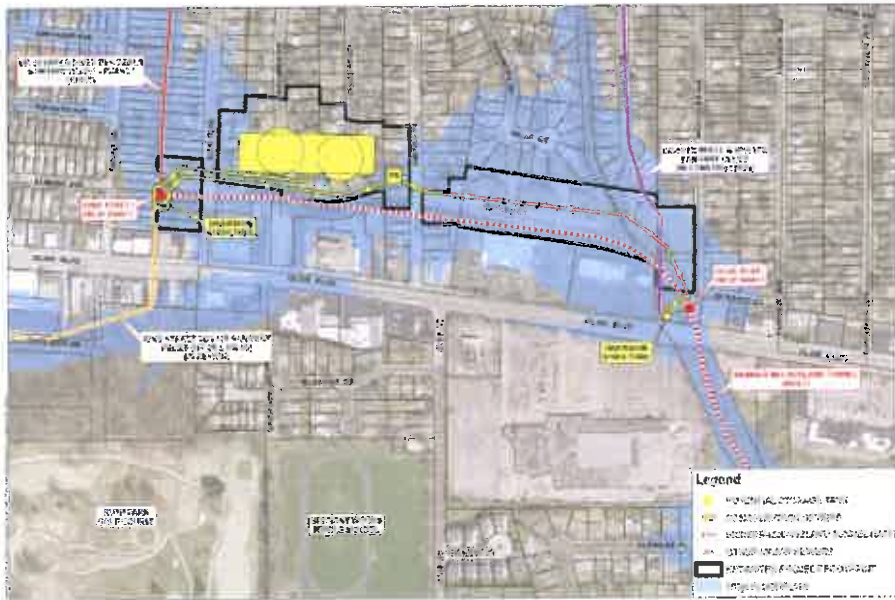

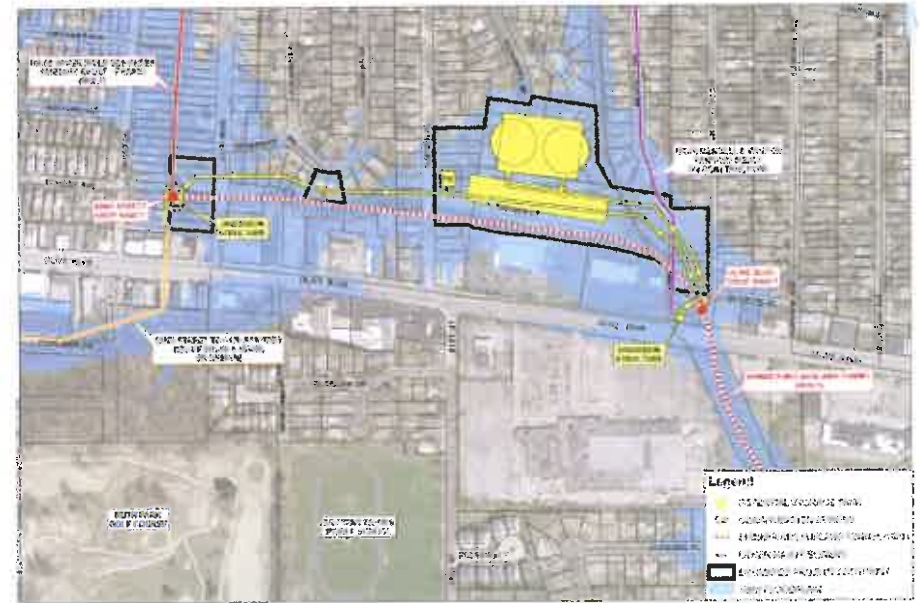

**Area A – All Options**

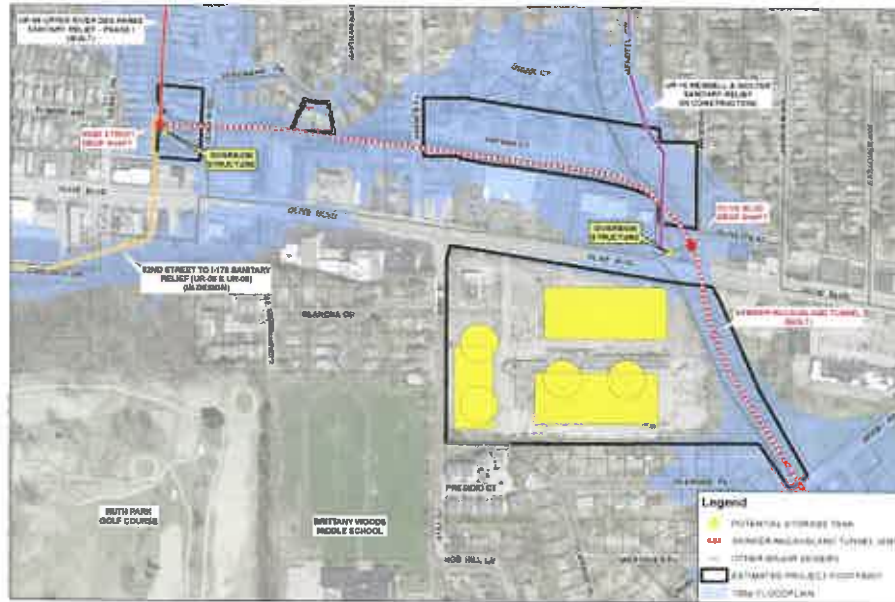
- Above ground and buried tank options
- Construction disruption north of River Des Peres
- Would require approximately 35-45 residential properties
- Removal of Hafner Court Apartments
- Estimated costs \$53 to \$63 million



**Area B – All Options**

- Above ground and buried tanks
- Construction disruption north of River Des Peres
- Would require approximately 25-35 residential properties
- Removal of Hafner Court Apartments
- Estimated costs \$55 to \$78 million

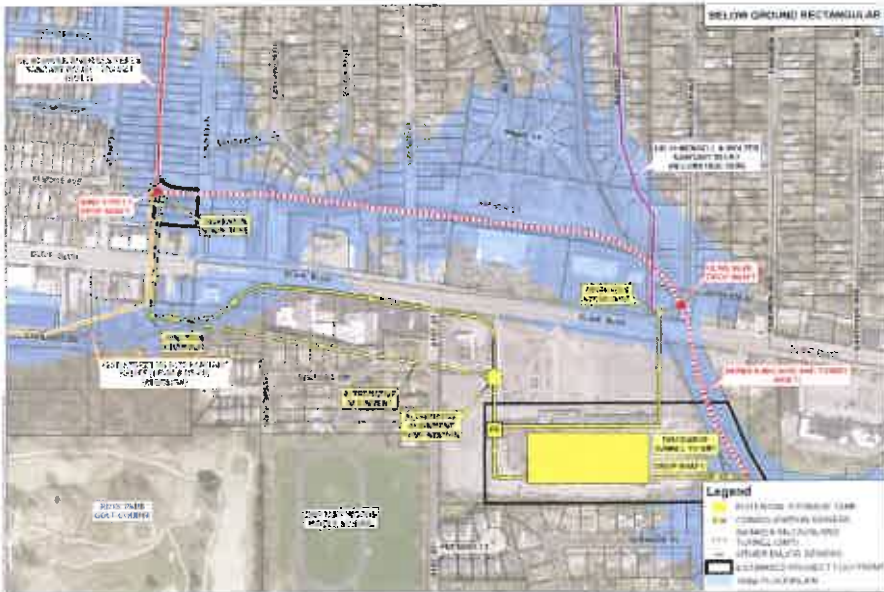


**Area C – Options 1-5**

- Above ground and buried tanks
- Construction disruption north and south of River Des Peres
- Would require 10-15 residential properties
- Commercial property impacts (parking)
- Commercial property purchase
- Removal of Hafner Court Apartments
- Estimated costs \$57 to \$90 million

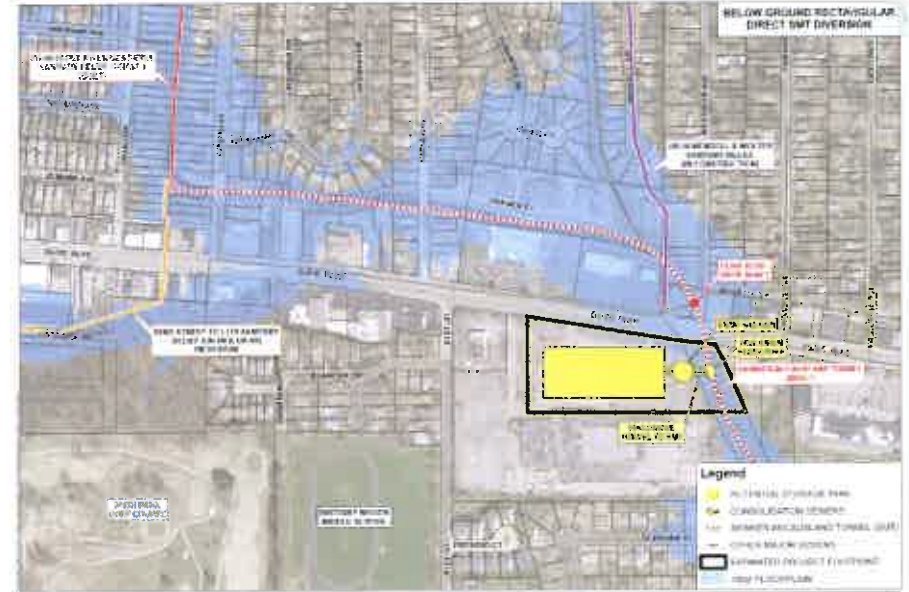

**Area C – Option 6**

- Buried tank
- Construction disruption mostly south of River Des Peres
- Would require permanent residential property easements
- Commercial property impacts (parking)
- Commercial property purchase
- Estimated Cost \$92 million

- Buried tank
- Commercial property impacts (parking)
- Commercial property purchase
- Above ground pump station (building)
- Estimated cost \$114 million

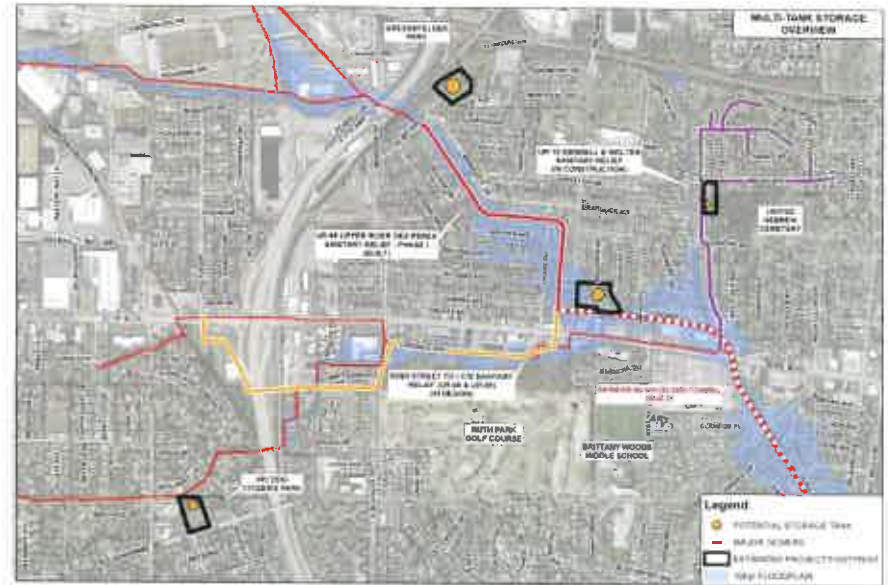
