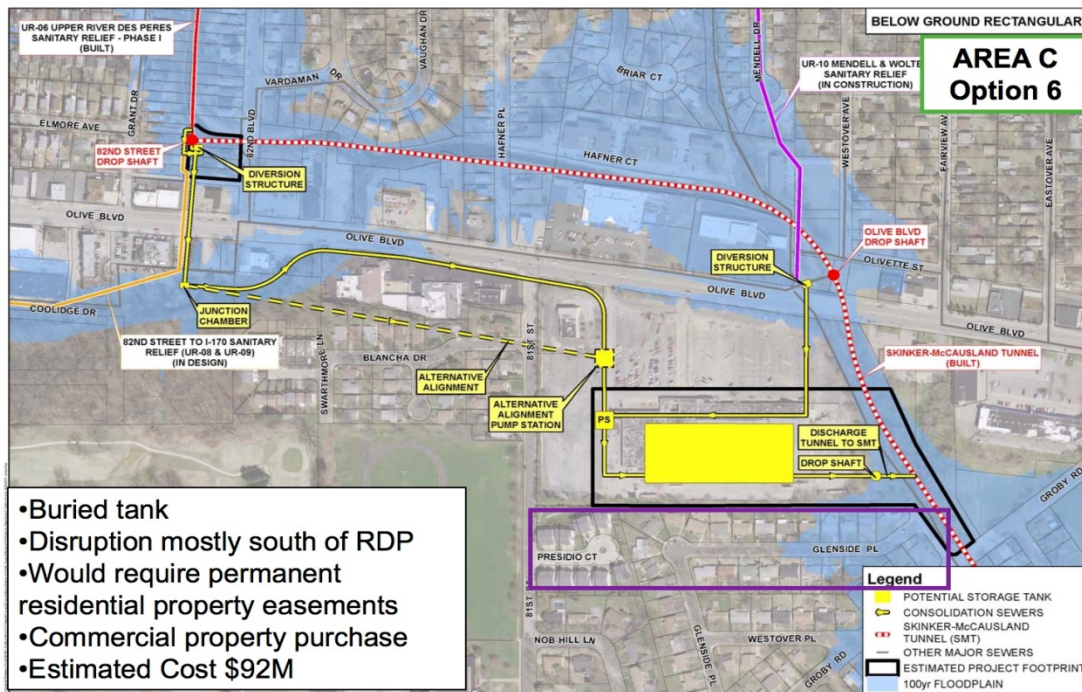

# Town Hall Meeting

## MSD's Proposed University City Sewage Storage Tank

Last January MSD recommended the selection of Area C Option 6 in Ward 2 of University City to MSD's Program Management Committee (MSD Board) on January 30th. A map of that area is shown below.

About the same time, Council authorized our City Manager Gregory Rose to obtain an engineering review of the three options shortlisted by the Council: Area C Option 6, Area C Option 7 and Area D Option 1. Mr. Rose asked MSD to postpone any further action until the City could obtain this review and MSD agreed.

There will be a Town Hall Meeting to talk about where we are today relative to the location of the MSD Sewage Storage Tank, and to hear what citizens have to say, especially those who live nearby the affected areas before the alignments and site layout are determined. City Manager Gregory Rose and Public Works Director Sinan Alpaslan will be there to present available information, answer questions and take note of citizen input. Please join us at this Town Hall Meeting, and if you know anyone might be interested or who lives in the area, please let them know about this meeting.
