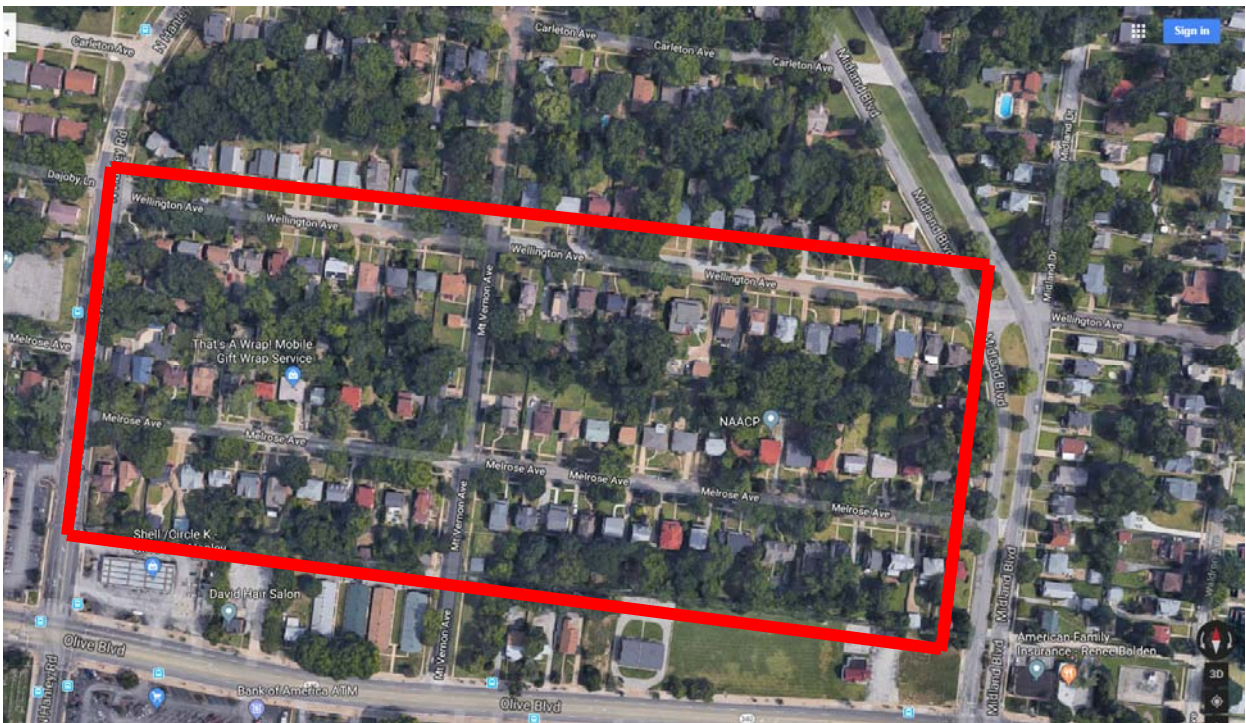

6665 Delmar – Temporary Cross Walk

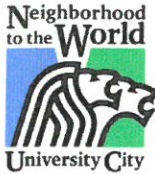


Request:
