PARK COMMISSION

General

- Consists of Seven (7) members
- Three Year Term
- Elect A President From Among Members
- Shall Make and Adopt Rules For Its Own Guidance as may be Expedient, Not Inconsistent with Charter or Ordinances

PARK COMMISSION

POWERS

- Survey and make plans for the maintenance of an adequate system of parks and recreational facilities and activities, and for the enlargement, improvement or acquisition of parks or recreational areas and activities and make recommendations therefor;

PARK COMMISSION

POWERS (cont'd)

- Approve rules and regulations for administration of parks and recreation activities of the Department of Public Works and Parks and Community Development which will become effective upon council approval.

PARK COMMISSION

Powers (cont'd)

- Perform other such duties with reference to the administration of parks and recreational activities of the Department of Public Works, Parks and Community Development, not inconsistent with the Charter, as may be provided by this code or by ordinance.

PARK COMMISSION

Powers (cont'd)

- Advise council and the Director of Public Works and Parks on administration problems with parks;
- Make any investigation which it may consider desirable with reference to the administration of the parks and report to the council at least once a year on its findings, conclusions, and recommendations;

Park Commission

- Review that portion of the annual budget of the City pertaining to parks and recreation in the Public Works, Parks and Community Development and make any recommendation directly to the City Manager and the Council;

Park Commission

Consideration of Ordinances

- Ordinances pertaining to parks or the recreational facilities must be considered by Commission before advancing to Council. Commission has 30 days to consider and make a recommendation to council.
