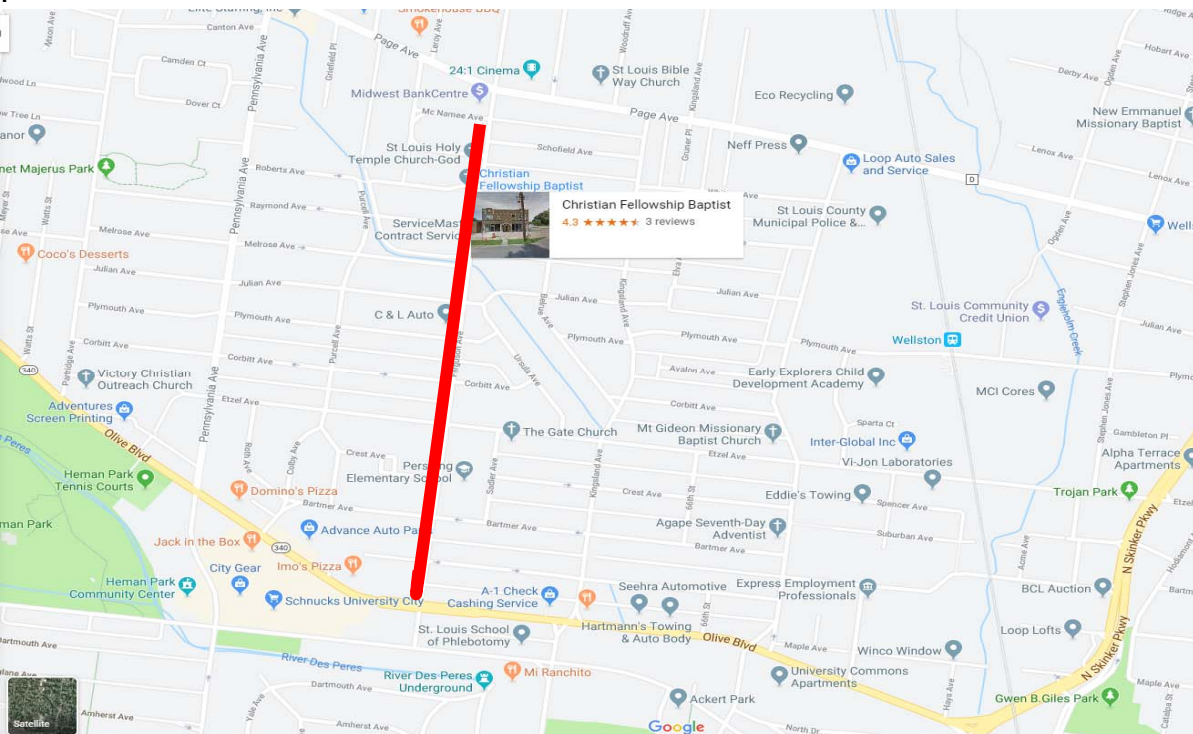

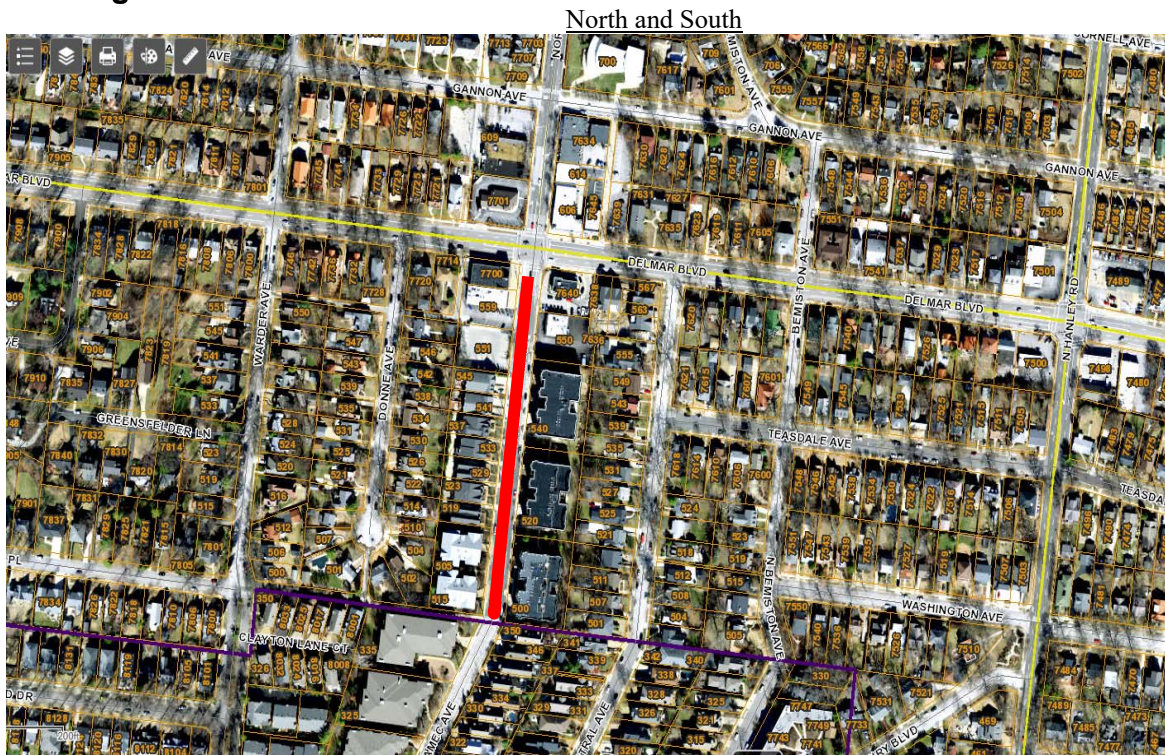

Existing Conditions:



Request:

Prohibit truck traffic except for utility vehicles and local deliveries.

Conclusion/Recommendation:

This area of North and South is City maintained, but lies between the portion that is in Clayton to the south and to the north is owned by ST. Louis County. The recommendation from Staff is that this section of North and South be improved with consideration to the road. The improvement would remove all the poor sections of the road and would be able to handle the truck traffic.

STATE THE NATURE OF YOUR REQUEST:

I request that truck traffic be prohibited on this section of the street, except for utility and local delivery, as it is a 2-lane, largely residential street. Currently, trucks (many of them heavy trucks) use North and South as a connector to and from Clayton.

WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING THAT THE CITY TAKE CONCERNING YOUR REQUEST?

Enact an ordinance to prohibit truck traffic on this street, except for utility and local delivery, erect signs indicating that truck traffic is prohibited, and provide enforcement of such.

Hanley Road is wider and better equipped to handle truck traffic going to and from Clayton. North and South is being torn up from heavy trucks.

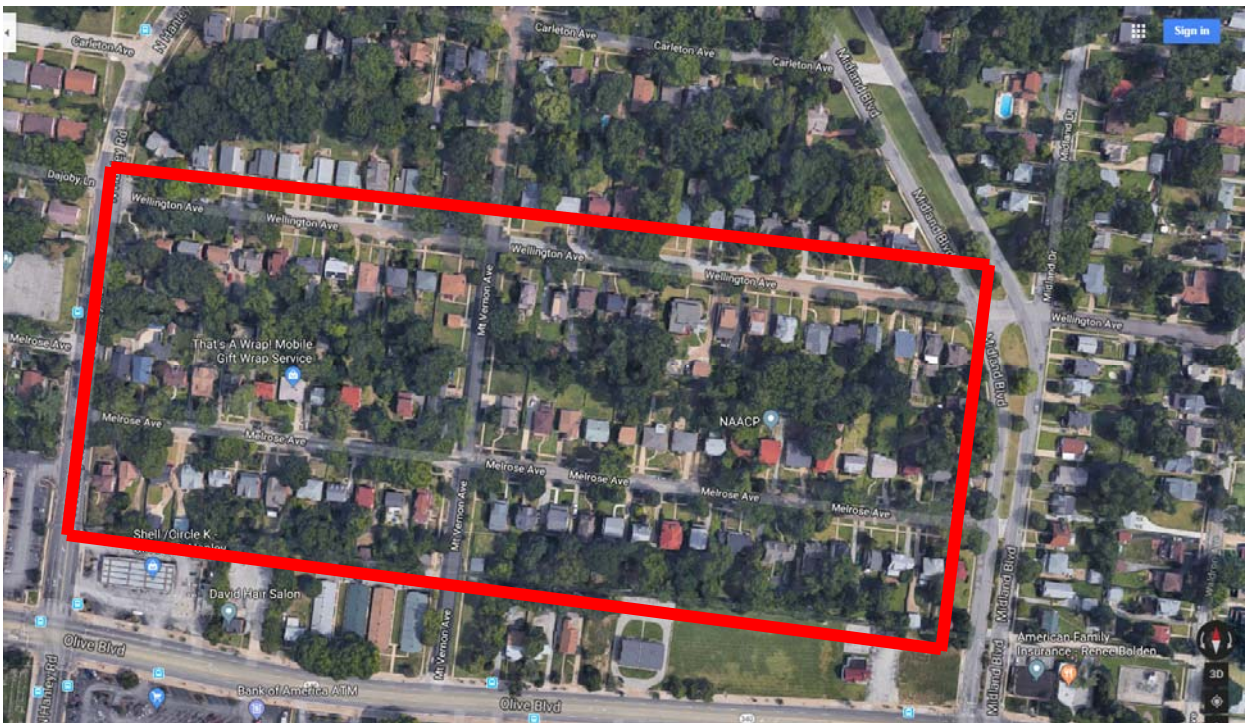

WHAT IMPACT WOULD THE ACTION HAVE ON ANY ADJACENT RESIDENTS OR STREETS?

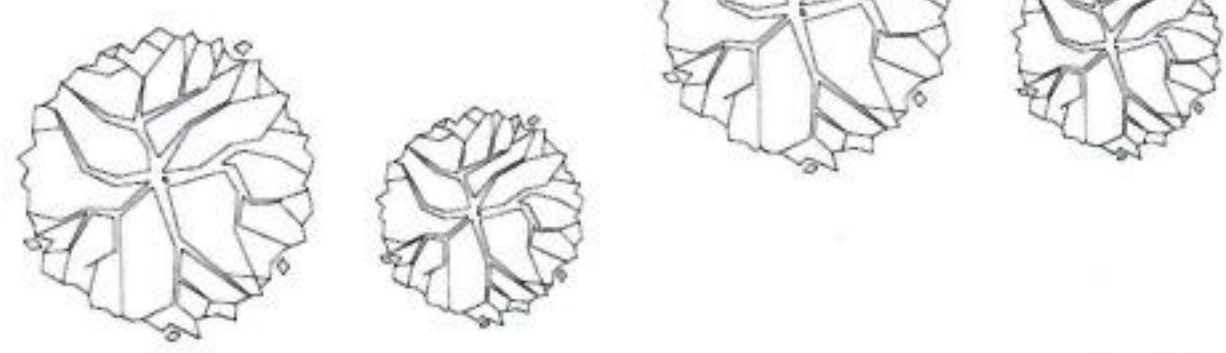
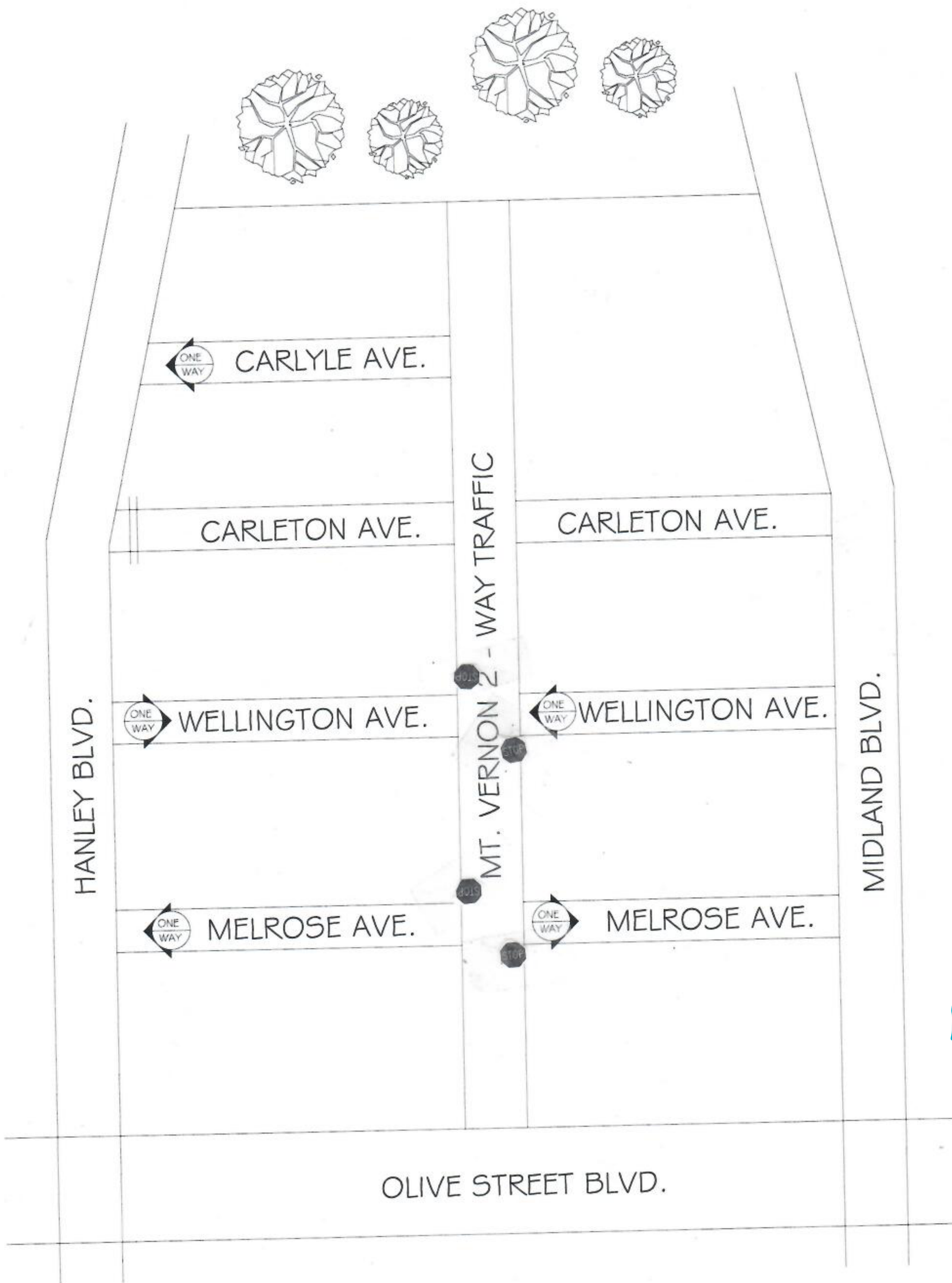

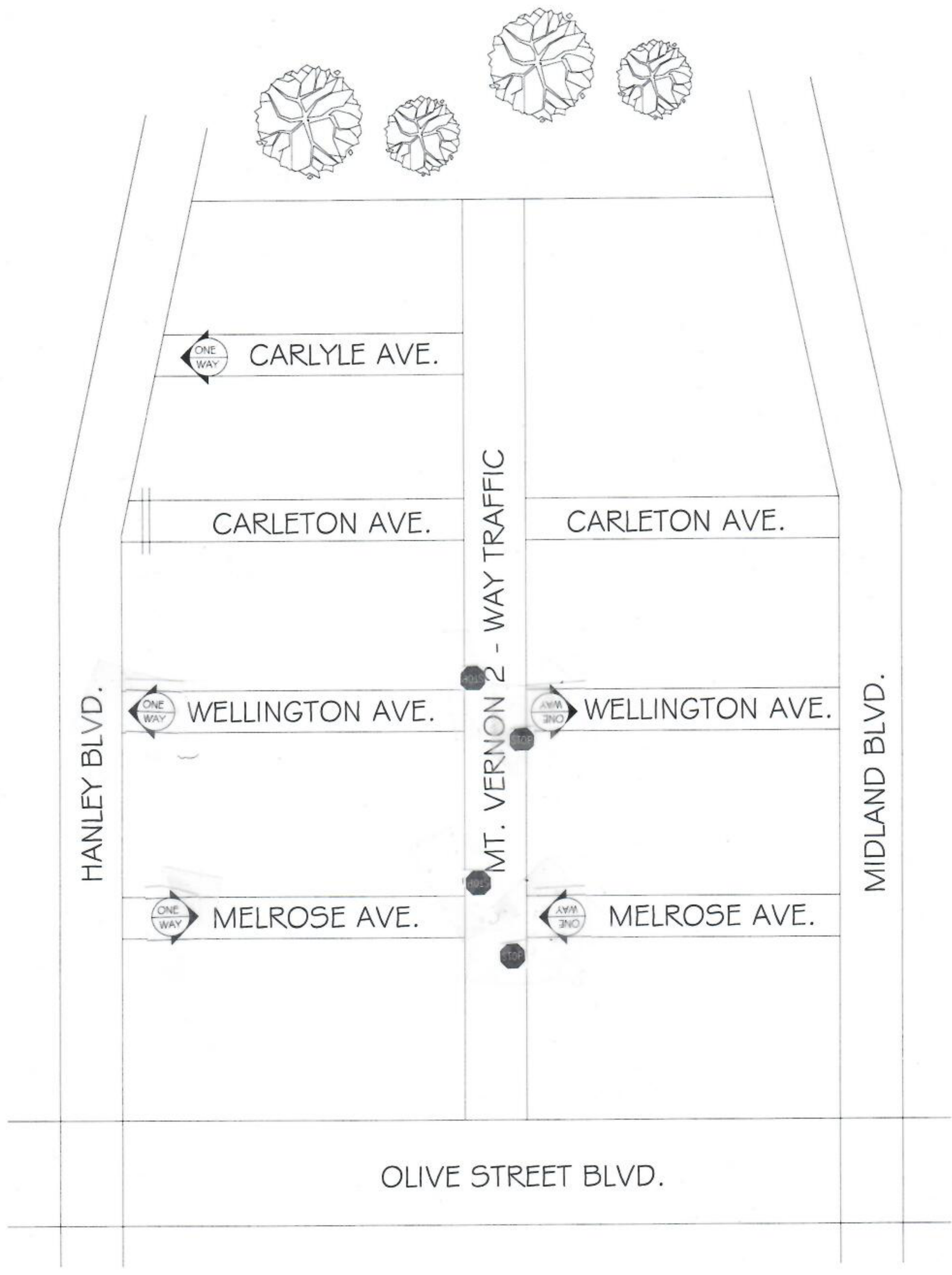

Existing Conditions:

Request

Cease enforcement of vehicles parking near stop signs because of the limited amount of space in the neighborhood for parking

Conclusion/Recommendation:

City staff recommends that the police department update the commission on the recent enforcement of these violations. Although the rule as read in the City ordinance reads; “It is unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a Police Officer or traffic control sign or signal. Within thirty (30) feet upon the approach of any flashing beacon or stop sign.”

STATE THE NATURE OF YOUR REQUEST:

Recent enforcement of parking near stop signs within University Park Subdivision. The new enforcement of no parking within 8ft of a stop sign leaves many residents as well as guests unable to park in front of a residence at all. Parking is already limited within the subdivision.

Our residents are unaware of the parking restrictions, per multiple violations attached, and will be informed of the Commissions decision.

WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING THAT THE CITY TAKE CONCERNING YOUR REQUEST?

I would like to discuss either waiving the enforcement, since parking is limited within the neighborhood already, moving the stop signs closer to the curbs and limiting the enforcement to 2-3 feet, so that at least one car can be parked, and painting curbs and no parking areas so that visitors are aware of the parking restrictions.

WHAT IMPACT WOULD THE ACTION HAVE ON ANY ADJACENT RESIDENTS OR STREETS?

Likely none since these violations were previously not enforced.

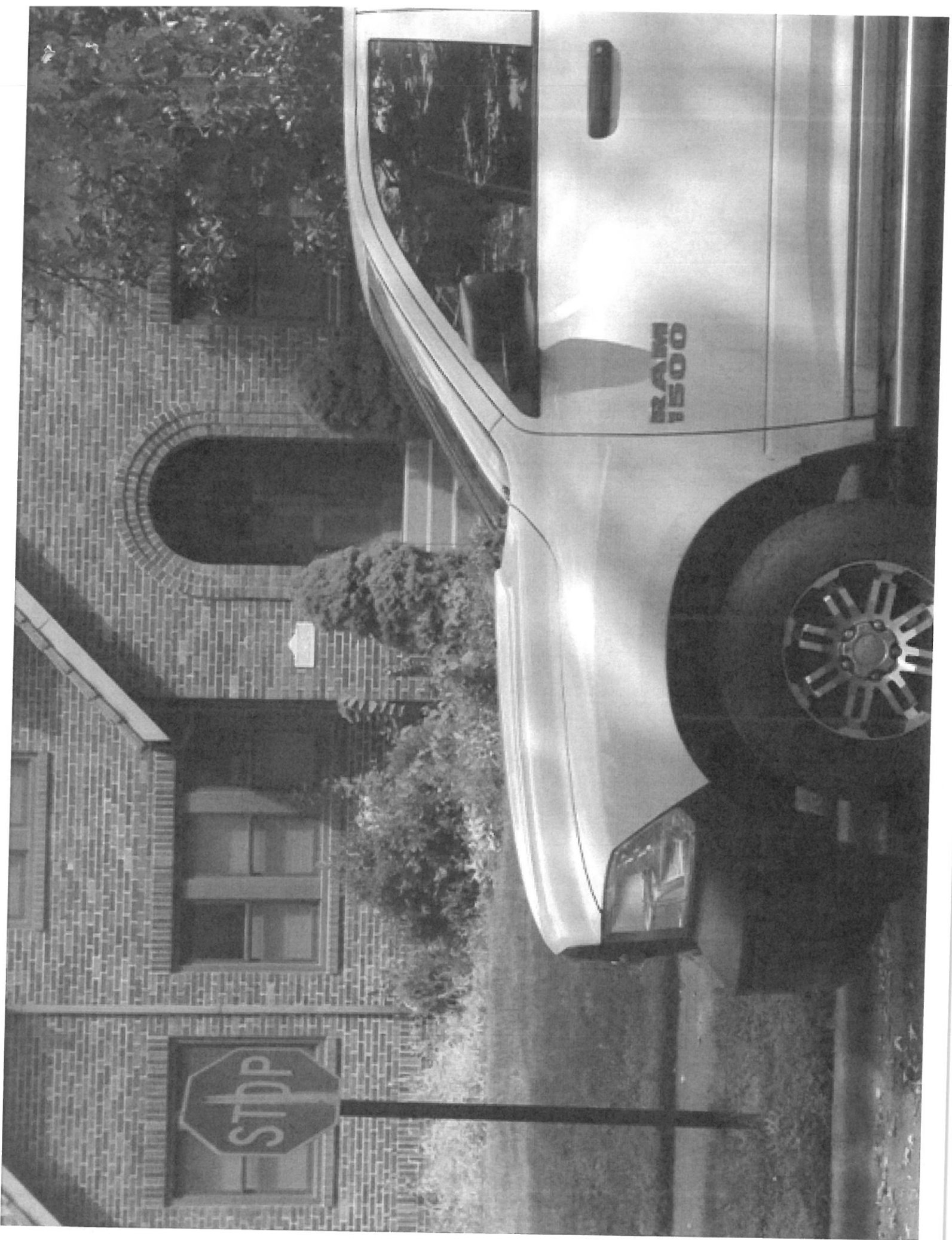
