- 2. Opening Round
 - a. Barbara Brain announced that Mitch Leachman, Director of Programs at St. Louis Audubon, received the 2020 Grow Native Pioneer Award. Mitch is the coordinator of the Bring Conservation Home Program.
 - b. Jenny Wendt reported a paper shredding event on 9/12/2020.
 - c. Jenny Wendt announced the River des Peres Trash Bash will be a week-long event beginning October 24th.
