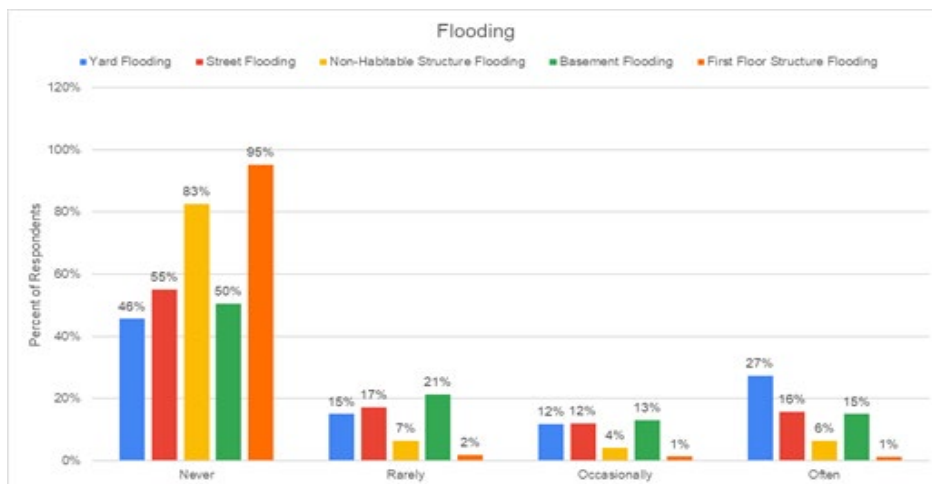
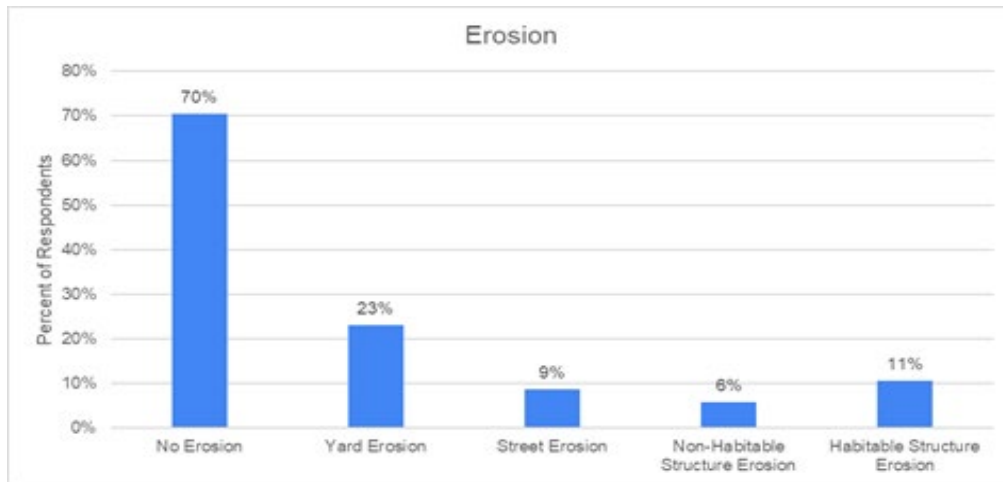

MINUTES OF THE STORMWATER COMMISSION July 5, 2022

1. **Call to Order.** The twenty-third meeting of the Stormwater Commission (Commission) was called to order at 6:35 PM by Chair Todd Thompson.
2. **Attendance-Roll Call.** The following Commission members were present at the Community Center: Garry Aronberg, Mark Holly, Eric Karch, Todd Thompson, Eric Stein. Also in attendance were Tim Cusick, Councilman, Gregory Rose, City Manager, Dawn Beasley, Assistant City Manager, John Mulligan, City Attorney.
3. **Agenda.** The Following Agenda was approved by voice vote (motion and second: Messrs. Karch, Criss): Roll Call; Approval of Agenda; Approval of Minutes; Announcements by Commissioners, Citizen Comments Committee Reports, New Business, Old Business, Council Liaison Comments; Adjournment. Accepted.
4. **Minutes.** The minutes of the May 3, 2022, Commission meeting were approved (Messrs. Stein, Holly, voice vote approval).
5. **Announcements.** During the City council meeting of Aug 8, ASFPM award for innovated community involvement in stormwater will be made. Photos will be taken that night
6. **Citizen Comments.**
 - None
7. **Subcommittee Reports.**
 - USACE Report. Corps personnel are working to finalizing report. Darren Dunkel has become the lead City contact. Negotiations with Overland for a detention basin along Woodson just north of the City Limits is progressing. Part of the site had been developed with Federal grants and the granting agency needs to be involved in the negotiations.
 - Early warning. Fire Department Chief Hinson is developing protocol for issuing notification to first responders.
8. **New Business.**
 - Stormwater Master Planning consultants Garry Aronberg and Eric Karch of HR Green and Reitz & Jens discussed questionnaire responses to date:
 - about 1000 responses
 - Spread-out throughout the City but slightly more responses from the first ward than the second and third wards.
 - A summary of responses is presented in two histograms included below and summarized in the two following bullet points:
 - Approximately 25 percent of respondents report erosion in their yards.
 - 2 percent of respondents report occasional to frequent flooding in the first floor.
 - Nearly 30 percent of respondents reported occasional to frequent basement flooding.



9. Old Business.

- Councilman Cusick and Commissioner Criss will knock on doors to get more questionnaire responses from the residents in the floodplain.
- HR Green will supply list of residents who have not yet responded.

10. Councilman Cusick Comments.

- Costco opening scheduled for fall 2022
- Renovation of annex and library planning is proceeding. Some fencing will be required around the police station.
- Code red is operational and is discussed on the City web site.
