


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

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 400.030 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY CITY, RELATING TO ZONING CODE DEFINITIONS, BY AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF DORMITORY.

WHEREAS, Chapter 400 (Zoning Code) of the Municipal Code of the City of University City, Missouri divides the City into several zoning districts and establishes standards to which land, buildings, structures and their uses must conform; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on December 14, 2022, the City Plan Commission reviewed a proposed amendment of the definition of Dormitory in Zoning Code Section 400.030; and

WHEREAS, due notice of a public hearing to be held by the City Council in the 5th Floor City Council Chambers at City Hall at 6:30 p.m., on ______, 2023, was duly published in the St. Louis Countian, a newspaper of general circulation within said City on ______, 202__; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held at the time and place specified in said notice, and all suggestions or objections concerning said text amendment of Zoning Code Section 400.030 were duly heard and considered by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY CITY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 400.030 of the Municipal Code of the City of University City, relating to Zoning Code Definitions, is hereby amended by amending the definition of Dormitory, so that the definition as so amended shall read as follows:

DORMITORY

A building or portion thereof which contains living quarters for students, staff or members of an accredited college, university, boarding school, theological school, hospital, religious order, or comparable organization; provided that said building is owned and managed by said organization.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage as provided by law.
