

RESOLUTION #2022-18

WHEREAS, the City of University City, Missouri (hereinafter called "the Subgrantee"), has made application through the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for funding from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, in the amount of \$6,722,950 for the total project cost; and


WHEREAS, the Subgrantee recognizes the fact that this grant is based on a cost share basis with the federal share not exceeding 75% and the non-federal share being a minimum of 25% of the total project cost. The minimum 25% non-federal share can be either cash or in-kind match; and

WHEREAS, the Subgrantee agrees to provide and make available up to \$1,680,738 of non-federal funds to be used to meet the minimum 25% match requirement for this mitigation grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY CITY, MO AS FOLLOWS:

The City of University City, Missouri agrees to provide and make available up to \$1,680,738 of non-federal funds to be used to meet the minimum 25% match requirement for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP).
