The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Diane Clark.

New commission member Gretchen Barry was welcomed.

Minutes: Ms. Huether moved to approve the November 15, 2021, minutes. Ms. Greenwald seconded. Minutes approved by acclamation. (Please note: Due to a lack of quorum, there were no minutes to approve since November 2021).

Council Liaison Report: Ms. Klein provided a status update about the Centennial Commons flooding including the Stormwater Commission and FEMA response. Status of the commercial redevelopment at Olive Blvd & I-70 was also discussed.
