- 1. Call to Order: The meeting began at 11:03 a.m. with a quorum.
- 2. Public Comments: Joe Edwards complimented Dan Wald on the installation of a new neon sign and shared details of the 51<sup>st</sup> Annual Blueberry Hill Dart Tournament. Mr. Edwards asked for the reason the previous LSBD Board meeting was rescheduled. Dan Wald indicated there were not enough board members to hold the meeting therefore it was rescheduled.

Mr. Wollager outlined why The Loop is the ideal location to rebrand as a premiere Art District in St Louis. He shared his vision for the Loop Wallz Mural Festival and other options to create a more vibrant and colorful area by painting

electrical boxes, vacant storefront windows, and existing bicycle racks.
