Staff Liaison Report: Ms. Euell-Taylor gave a brief report. The Thursday bingo event continues to be a success. Mister Gary with *Them Yo' People* will be the guest bingo announcer for the December 12th event. The Senior Services Coordinator position is posted on the website, no other update.

Council Liaison Report: Mr. Tieman gave an update on building construction in University City. The building at Kingsland and Delmar on the Loop is being demolished. A new five story building will be constructed on the site. The Dierbergs planned for east of I-170 has been approved. Jeff Hale's soon to be vacated 1st Ward position on the city council is open for a temporary replacement. The new Jewish Student Union is open on Delmar. A new solid waste/recycling task force is looking for members.
