A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ST. LOUIS REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of University City, Missouri recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within University City; and

WHEREAS, University City has participated in the preparation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the St. Louis Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan ("Plan") in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City Council demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan.

The City of University City, Missouri hereby adopts the final FEMA-approved 2025-2030 St. Louis Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
