Senior Services Survey update: Latest draft was presented to commission and will be sent later to commissioners. The final will go to not only seniors but also families and care givers of seniors giving us the data to decide on what we can offer. Methods of distribution were also given.

Also: Ms. Euell-Taylor reported a Laughter Lunch and Bingo event will ask attending seniors to bring non-perishable food goods. The city is collecting food for Thanksgiving meals till November 25.
