Weekly Collections — at your curbside

Single Stream Recycling - Place ALL recyclables in one cart!


- Aluminum, steel and tin cans, glass bottles/jars, and #1 thru #7 plastics
- NO #6 (Styrofoam material) accepted
- · Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper, and other fiber/paper products
- Cardboard (tear into small sections to fit inside the cart)

Drop off center/recycling: take items to rear parking lot of 975 Pennsylvania (between Vernon & Olive)

Special Collections

Holiday trees will be collected by city workers during the weeks of January 3 and 9. Motor oil can be recycled at any Valvoline Instant Oil Change, Jiffy Lube, or BP/Amoco. Tires can be recycled at BP/Amoco (725.7558). A fee may apply. For recycling information call: 505.8560.

STORM DAMAGE

- The Forestry Division maintains trees on public rights of way, in parks and on other public properties.
- After a storm, city workers clear the streets of downed tree limbs on an emergency basis.
- Trees on private property must be maintained by the owners.
- Limbs less than 3 inches in diameter may be cut into 4 foot lengths and bundled for city collection.
- Property owners must dispose of any debris from privately owned trees at their own expense.
- To report damage to public right of way trees, or limbs blocking streets, call: 505.8619.

RAIN BARREL PROGRAM

Help manage storm water and improve water quality in University City by installing a Rain Barrel. Rain barrels capture storm water runoff from your roof. You can re-use the water for flower/vegetable gardens and household plants. For more information or to purchase your rain barrel from the River des Peres Watershed Coalition, visit www.riverdesperes.org

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- On regular collection days, yard waste is collected if contained in biodegradable bags and tagged with Yard Waste Stickers, which are available (\$1.50 each) at: City Hall-Finance, Schnucks, Walgreens, BP/Amoco, University Gardens, Centennial Commons, and Williams Pharmacy.
- Yard waste stickers are NOT required October 15 thru December 31.


Leaf Collection Schedule



BULK ITEM COLLECTION — now in Spring & Fall

- Dispose of large furniture and appliances (stoves, refrigerator, water heaters, washers, dryers).
- Place no more than 3 large items or 7 smaller items within 1–3 feet of curb or street pavement for collection. Do not place items in the alley.
- Place items curbside by Sunday night of collection week. Don't miss your collection!
- Be sure that access to the items is not blocked by parked vehicles.
- For everyone's safety, wrap glass doors and tables, windows and mirrors with cardboard.
- Remove freon from refrigerators and air conditioners.

UNIVERSITY CITY GOOD NEIGHBOR POLICY

Property Upkeep

- Residents are required to keep their property clean and free of trash.
- Residential grass should be maintained shorter than 7 inches.
- Residents may not place signs of any kind in tree lawns, parks or other public land, on utility poles or trees.
- Post house numbers so they are visible from both street and alley.
- Cordwood, pallets, cardboard and barrels must be placed in an open rack at least 15 inches from the ground.
- Derelict or unlicensed autos may NOT be kept on the street or on private property.
- No vehicle may be parked on a public street for more than five consecutive days without being moved.

Truck Parkina

• Non–commercial trucks owned by a resident may be parked in front of the resident's home upon payment of a one time \$25 inspection fee. (Obtain from Finance Department).

Refuse and Yard Waste Collection

- Collection time begins at 7 am year-round. Place refuse carts out no earlier than 4 pm the day before
 collection. Remove carts on the day of collection, except when advised by the Public Works Department.
- Do not burn refuse of any kind, or sweep litter and refuse into the street.
- Place brush for collection in bundles not to exceed 4 feet long and 2 feet around (maximum 6 bundles per pickup).
- Branches should be no more than 3" in diameter. Tree logs, stumps or trunks will NOT be collected.

Pets

- Vaccinate and obtain a city license for all dogs. City ordinance requires a special permit for pit bulldogs.
- A pet clinic is held for vaccinations on the first Saturday in April at HPCC, 975 Pennsylvania.
- Observe ordinances regarding leashes and dog waste. Two animals are allowed in a single family residence; one in multi – family unit.
- · Loud & continuous dog barking is a municipal violation subject to fines & should be reported to the police.

Permits

- An occupancy permit must be obtained prior to moving into a house, apartment, institution or business. (Obtain in Community Development Department).
- Permits for building, plumbing or electrical work, and installing or painting signs must be obtained prior to beginning the project. (Obtain in Community Development).
- Residents, businesses, contractors and utility companies must acquire a permit before performing any work
 or placing dumpsters or items on public right of way (curbs, sidewalks, gutters, streets, alleys, tree lawns and
 driveways) or installing banners on light poles. (Obtain in Public Works).

Disability Services

- City Hall is fully accessible from the parking lot off Trinity Avenue.
- Disabled residents may receive a smaller trash cart or rollout service upon submission of doctor's statement to Public Works Dept. and no one at residence is able to pull out regular cart.
- Public Works will provide a Disabled Parking space and signs on city maintained streets adjacent to a resident's home when established criteria are met. For information, call: 505.8560.
- For city recreation inclusion services, call: 505.8607.

UNIVERSITY CITY SCHOOLS
