Dog Play Area Improvement and Maintenance Agreement

- In 2002, City entered into an agreement with the U. City People for Dogs, Inc. a 501©(3) not-for-profit charitable corporation.
- As part of the agreement, the City would:
 1. Designate property as a "dog play area".
 2. Cut any grass and collect refuse.
 3. City collect license fees (Current Fees - \$40-Resident and \$60 – Non-Resident).

Dog Play Area Improvement And Maintenance Agreement

- U. City People for Dogs, Inc. would:
 1. Construct fence and other structures.
 2. Establish rules and regulations.
 3. Maintain property and improvements.

Proposal – Terminate Original Agreement

- City would except responsibility of operating UCity Dog Park.
- City would collect and keep all fees.
- City would establish Dog Park as a City Park by Ordinance.
- City would establish new rules and regulations.
- City would maintain Dog Park.

Proposal – Terminate Original Agreement

- U. City People for Dogs, Inc. would relinquish all on-site assets to City.
- U. City People for Dogs, Inc. would donate \$20,000 to the City for the construction of a pavilion to be placed at the Dog Park.
- U City People for Dogs, Inc. would continue to volunteer and assist the City in programs and activities for dogs.
